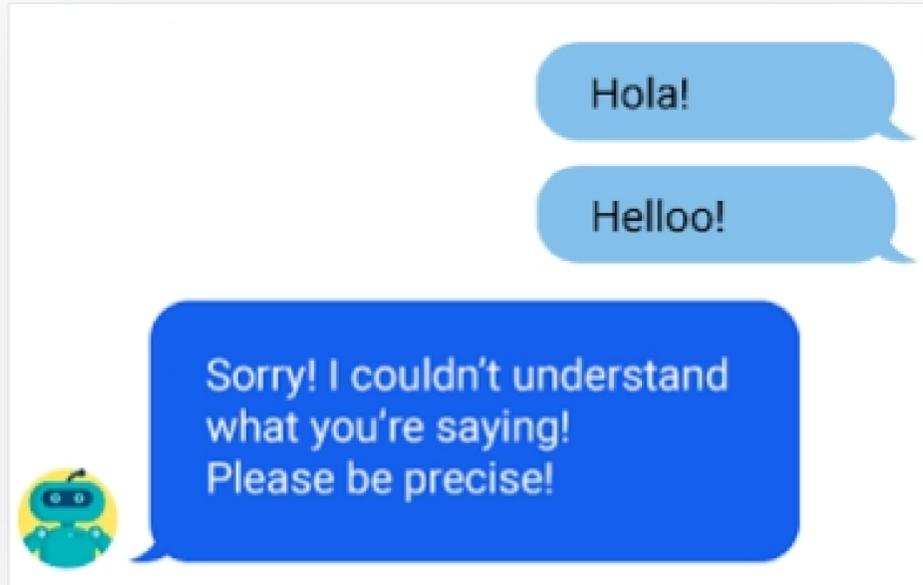

De-Mystifying AI Terms

- **Generative AI:** Can create content from prompts
- **Large Language Model (LLM):** How AI understands language
- **Training Data:** Knowledge AI searches to create a response
- **Generative Pre-Trained Transformer (GPT):** Combination of the above

History of AI



CHATBOTS

- Needs a person to "code" every response in the chatbot, which is time consuming
- Inaccurate if given an imperfect input, synonyms, or misspellings



SUPERVISED LEARNING (IBM WATSON)

- More accurate than a chatbot
- Starts at 0 knowledge, so need LOADS of training data to work
- Expensive and requires dedicated staff to manage



AI TODAY (GPT'S)

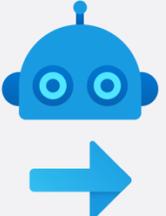
- Pre-trained with advanced language models for superior understanding out of the box

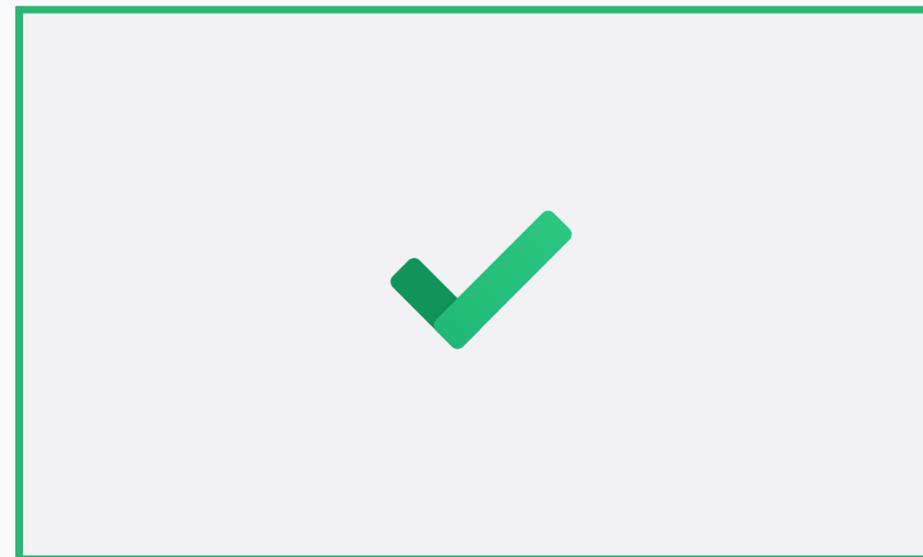

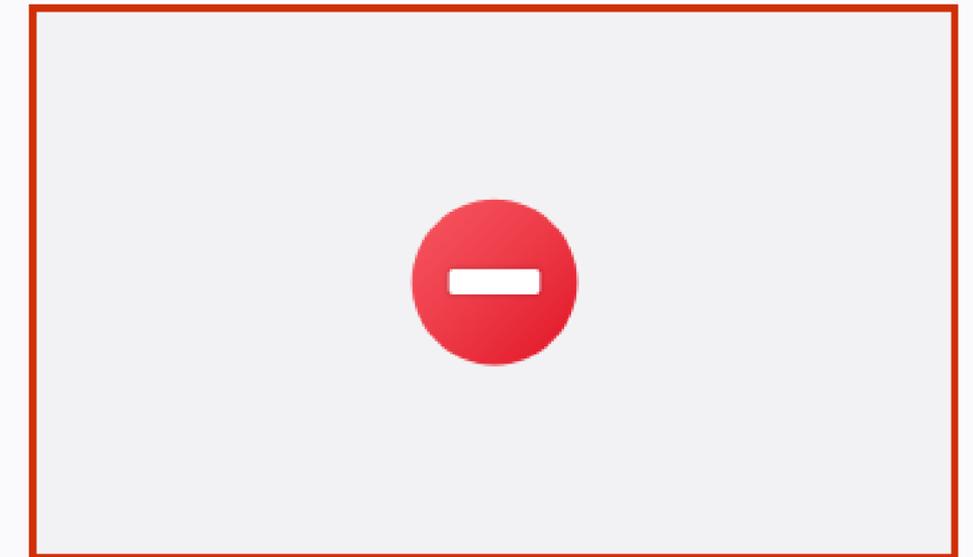
WHAT IS AI?

- Take fuzzy inputs and provide a clear output
- Understand context and adapt based on information
- Reason and problem-solve
